At its December 13, 2017 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the above referenced matter. Pursuant to Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, and based on the information received, as well as that given in a presentation by Anthony Ceglio, Airport Manager, Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning, Division of Aviation the Council advises the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, in CEQ Resolution No. 55-2017, a copy of which is attached, that the proposed project be considered a Type I Action under SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment.

If the Legislature concurs with the Council on Environmental Quality's recommendation that the project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment, the Presiding Officer should cause to be brought before the Legislature for a vote, a resolution determining that the proposed action is a Type I Action pursuant to SEQRA that will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment (negative declaration). However, if the Legislature has further environmental concerns regarding this project and needs additional information, the Presiding Officer should remand the case back to the initiating unit for the necessary changes to the project and EAF or submit a resolution authorizing the initiating unit to prepare a draft environmental impact statement (positive declaration).

CEQ RESOLUTION NO. 55-2017, RECOMMENDATION CONCERNING A SEQRA CLASSIFICATION AND DETERMINATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 450 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE FOR THE PROPOSED PARKING AT SUFFOLK COUNTY GABRESKI AIRPORT FOR THE USGA GOLF OPEN, JUNE 11-17, 2018, TOWN OF SOUTHAMPTON

- WHEREAS, at its December 13, 2017 meeting, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) reviewed the EAF and associated information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Economic Development and Planning, Division of Aviation; and
- WHEREAS, a presentation regarding the project was given at the meeting by Anthony Ceglio, Airport Manager, Suffolk County Economic Development and Planning, Division of Aviation; and
- WHEREAS, the USGA proposes to use certain portions of Gabreski Airport property as general spectator parking as indicated in Part I of the Project EAF dated August 28, 2017; and
- WHEREAS, the use of the Gabreski Airport for the proposed 2018 USGA Golf Open Parking would be authorized by a lease agreement between Suffolk County and the USGA; and
- WHEREAS, based on discussions with the USGA and past experience it is anticipated that only the designated northeast parking areas indicated in the August 28, 2017 EAF are anticipated to be used; and
- **WHEREAS**, this designated northeast parking location is approximately 50 acres in size and is the same location that was used for parking at the 2004 USGA Golf Open; and
- WHEREAS, the vegetation in this 50 acre area is limited to grass which is mowed and maintained in accordance with FAA requirements; and
- WHEREAS, it is anticipated that approximately 4,500 cars per day will park on the site and the parking will be limited to daily parking (cars will not remain overnight) for attendees of the US Open on a complimentary basis during the week of the championship; and
- WHEREAS, a complimentary shuttle bus service will be provided from the Gabreski Airport parking area to and from the championship grounds at the Shinnecock Hills Golf Club beginning at approximately 5:00 a.m. and ending at 11:00 p.m.; and
- WHEREAS, traffic control plans will be coordinated with the Suffolk County Department of Public Works, the Town of Southampton, the Village of Westhampton Beach, the County Sheriff's Department, Southampton Police and the New York State Police; and
- WHEREAS, the USGA parking plan for Gabreski Airport is similar in nature to the parking plans for the three previous Opens held in 1986, 1995 and 2004; and
- WHEREAS, for the most recent USGA Golf Open Parking event at Gabreski Airport in 2004, the CEQ recommended and the Suffolk County Legislature adopted a Type I, Negative Declaration SEQRA determination; now, therefore be it

- 1st RESOLVED, that based on the information received and presented, a quorum of the CEQ hereby recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive that the proposed activity be classified as a Type I Action under the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and, be it further
- **2nd RESOLVED,** that based on the information received, a quorum of the CEQ recommends to the Suffolk County Legislature and County Executive, pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617 and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, that the proposed project will not have significant adverse impacts on the environment for the following reasons:
 - 1. The proposed action will not exceed any of the criteria of 6 NYCRR, Section 617.7, which sets forth thresholds for determining significant effect on the environment;
 - 2. The proposal does not appear to significantly threaten any unique or highly valuable environmental or cultural resources as identified in or regulated by the Environmental Conservation Law of the State of New York or the Suffolk County Charter and Code:
 - 3. The parcel does not appear to suffer from any severe environmental development constraints (no poor soil properties, no high groundwater and no unmanageable slopes);
 - 4. The proposal is a temporary use;
 - 5. Parking will be accommodated on already cleared areas at the airport;
 - 6. The proposed temporary use is being reviewed by the FAA and is compatible with the airport and will not negatively affect the safety of operations there;
